Presentation

Lubric[®] Mono Sterile Lubricant Eye Drops: Each single use container contains Hypromellose USP 5 mg/ml.

Description

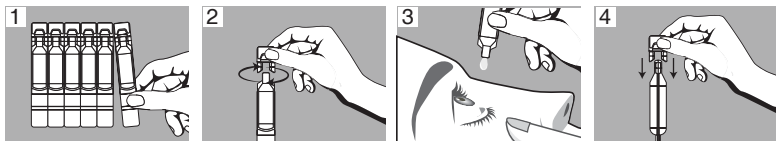
Lubric[®] Mono is the preparation of Hypromellose. It is a clear and colorless aqueous solution. Hypromellose lubricates the surface of the eye in the same way as natural tears. It can therefore be used to relieve the dryness and pain associated with reduced or abnormal tear production.

Indications and uses

Hypromellose 0.5% is used to treat dry eye conditions where there is not enough tears are produced to keep the eye lubricated and clean.

Dosage and Administration

To open the single use container, first hold the unit by the label end, remove a single dose unit from the pack (see picture 1). Twist and pull the head of the container to remove (see picture 2). Instill 1 drop 3 or 4 times in a day in the affected eye(s) as needed or as directed by the physician (see picture 3). While closing the container, turn the head at a 90° angle in relation to the container, and with a slight force, press the head onto the container tip. (see picture 4). After each use close the head properly. Discard the single use container after 12 hours of opening.



Side effects

Blurred vision. Matting or stickiness of eyelashes.

Precautions

If you experience eye pain, changes in vision, continued redness or irritation of the eye or if your symptoms continue for more than 3 days or become worse, check with your doctor. Concomitant ocular medication should be administered 15 minutes apart to the instillation of this eye drop. To avoid contamination, do not touch tip of container to any surface. Do not use after 12 hours of opening. Do not touch single use container tip to eye. If the solution changes color or becomes cloudy, do not use the eye drops.

Contraindication

It is contraindicated in patients with known sensitivity to any ingredient in this formulation.

Use in pregnancy and lactation

Use in Pregnancy: Hypromellose has not been shown to cause birth defects or other problems in humans.

Use in Lactation: Hypromellose has not been reported to cause problems in nursing babies.

Pediatric use

This drug does not cause different side effects or problems in children than it does in adults.

Drug interaction

Specific drug interaction studies have not been conducted with Hypromellose eye drops.

Overdose

Any adverse effect of overdose is not found.

Storage

Do not store above 30 °C. Keep away from light and out of the reach of children. Discard the single use container after 12 hours of opening.

Commercial Pack

Lubric[®] Mono Sterile Lubricant Eye Drops: Each single use container contains 0.5 ml of Sterile Lubricant Eye Drops.
